#### Travel costs:

Prior to booking your travels, please make sure that you received a confirmation from the AGSM and that you have read and agreed to all the COVID-19 related conditions. Please keep in mind to choose the cheapest means of travel. In case you will arrive by other means than car, please inform us about your travel in advance. We can reimburse up to 250€ for plane/train travels. For travels by car we can reimburse 0,20€/Km up to maximum 150,00€ (plus toll).

If you wish to receive your travel costs reimbursed, you should fill in the excel sheet that was sent together with this information and send it to agsm@fuen.org prior to the seminar.

In order to receive the reimbursement, participants must participate in the complete programme of the seminar. No Taxi or 1st Class/Business tickets will be reimbursed by the FUEN!

### Travel:

If you arrive by train / bus / plane, please inform us of your journey and the exact time of arrival / departure. The nearest airport is Vienna (VIE), which is very well connected with most European destinations. The FUEN does not organise shuttles from/to the airport, but we will try to support you with the organisation and planning.

### BY TRAIN:

Travel to Vienna main railway station (Wien Hauptbahnhof) and from there you can walk to Hotel (750m, 9minutes).
