#### **Registration:**

#### Travel costs:

Prior to booking your travels, please make sure that you received a confirmation from the AGSM and that you have read and agreed to all the COVID-19 related conditions of FUEN (page 2). Please keep in mind to choose the cheapest means of travel. In case you will arrive by other means than car, please inform us about your travel in advance. For the travels by car we can reimburse  $0.20 \in K$ m up to maximal  $150.00 \in K$ .

If you wish to receive your travel costs reimbursed, you should fill in the excel sheet that was sent together with this information and send it to <a href="mailto:agsm@fuen.org">agsm@fuen.org</a> prior to the seminar.

In order to receive the reimbursement, participants must participate in the complete programme of the seminar. No Taxi or 1st Class/Business tickets will be reimbursed by the FUEN!

# **COVID-19 related regulations for AGSM Seminar 2021** participation

Please note that participation at the AGSM Seminar 2021 is restricted due to the Corona pandemic. Please read our conditions of participation carefully before registering:

### **FOLLOW THE ENTRY REGULATIONS**

Participants arriving from an area subject to mandatory quarantine at the time of the AGSM Seminar according to Italian entry regulations, regardless of whether one is vaccinated, tested or recovered, will NOT be able to attend the Seminar. These are those states/territories that are not listed under categories A, B or C.

## Please read carefully the entry regulations of Italy.

In deviation from the entry regulations of Italy, we kindly ask you to observe the regulations of your home country or country of residence, which are mandatory for entry into Italy, Molise. Please enquire with the competent authority of your country of residence or the country from which you will be travelling to the AGSM Seminar.

### TESTED. VACCINATED. RECOVERED.

All participants must:

- Provide official evidence of full recovery; or
- Provide evidence that you are fully immunized with an EMA-approved vaccine (Biontech / Pfizer, Moderna, Johnson & Johnson, AstraZeneca).
- Or provide a PCR test not older than 48 hours. Alternatively, an antigen test from an official testing center that is not older than 24 hours can be submitted.

## **OBSERVE ENTRY REQUIREMENTS**

Deviating from these conditions of the FUEN, the respective entry regulations of Italy and your home country or country of residence must be observed, which are mandatory for entry into Italy, Molise. Please check with the relevant authority in your country of residence or the country from which you will be travelling to the AGSM Seminar.
